Reminder: Still time to apply for PPP loans

Congress passed the Paycheck Protection Program Flexibility Act (PPPFA) on June 3, 2020, which the President signed into law on June 5. The PPPFA provides more flexibility for borrowers under the Paycheck Protection Program and makes it easier for such borrowers to qualify for loan forgiveness for a greater portion of their loans. The PPP loans section in the summary below (most notably the "Forgiveness" section) has been updated to reflect the provisions of the PPPFA. The changes to the CARES Act made by the PPPFA are retroactively

applicable as if they were included in the original CARES Act, except for the change to the term of the loan (click on link below for complete summary).
